Commitment to achieving Net Zero

Orostream International Contracts is committed to achieving Net Zero emissions by, or before 2050.

Baseline Emissions Footprint

Baseline emissions are a record of the greenhouse gases that have been produced in the past and were produced prior to the introduction of any strategies to reduce emissions. Baseline emissions are the reference point against which emissions reduction can be measured.

Baseline Year: March 2022- March 2023

Additional Details relating to the Baseline Emissions calculations.

These figures are the baseline as there has been no prior reporting, scope three emissions at this time only relate to business air travel as details for materials are not yet sufficiently robust to give meaningful statistics.

Figures included in this baseline include purchased electricity (0), boiler emissions, air-conditioning emissions (0), company vehicles and air travel to overseas sites.

Scope Three Emissions have increased in the 2026 period from the baseline because the OSI activities have a higher volume of overseas projects which have required increased air travel to projects. The nature of Orostream International Contracts Ltd is the delivery of overseas work and as a result to a large degree out of control of the business due to the nature of the projects. Orostream International Contracts Ltd is going through a period of significant growth, which is also contributing to the increase in its carbon footprint.

Emissions from electricity use the market-based methodology to convert kWh to carbon

Exact figures for vehicle emissions were not available for this calculation due to there not being a full 12 month period of mileages available so these are estimated.

Initially scope three emissions are anticipated to rise as data for materials becomes more available within the market for SMEs.

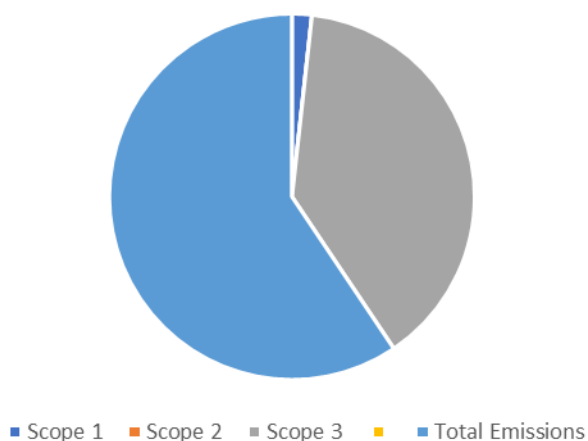

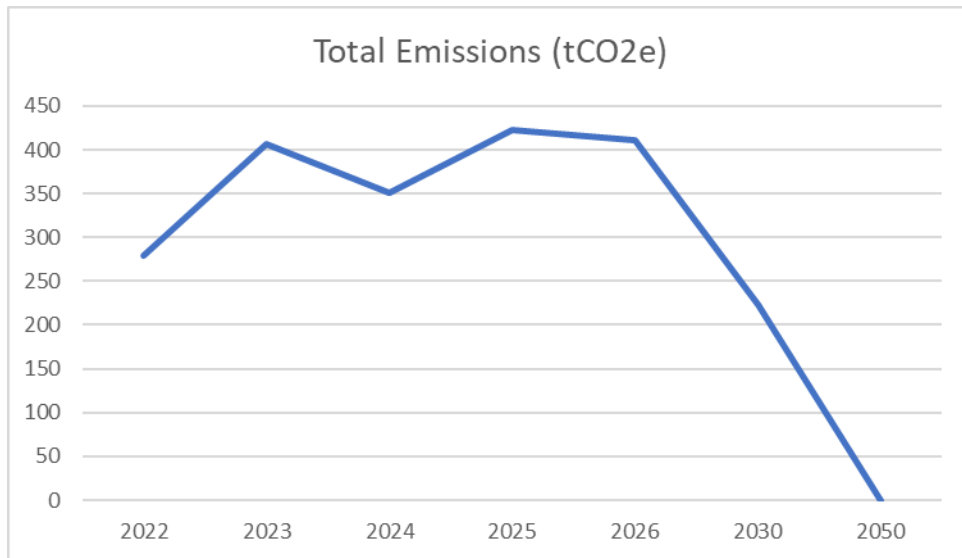


Emissions reduction targets

In order to continue our progress to achieving Net Zero, we have adopted the following carbon reduction targets.

We project that carbon emissions will decrease over the next five years to 223 tCO₂e by 2030. This is a reduction of 20%

Carbon Reduction Projects

Completed Carbon Reduction Initiatives

The following environmental management measures and projects have been completed within the last 5 years and already contribute to a reduced carbon footprint.

- Maintenance of ISO14001:2015.
- Installation of energy efficient lighting.
- Installation of new, efficient boiler.
- Installation of new air-conditioning which has had zero emissions.
- Electricity purchased from supplier who only purchases renewable energy.
- Purchase of EV's where appropriate
- Use of overseas operatives where possible to reduce travel-related Scope 3 emissions. Air travel is currently the largest challenge due to the nature and location of many OSi projects, but this is being balanced by working with a broader base of UK companies.

Future Carbon Reduction Initiatives

In the future, we aim to implement further measures such as:

- Further purchase of EVs where appropriate.
- Ongoing upgrades to further improve energy efficiency.
- Reduced travel where this will not impact project delivery.
- Selection of suppliers who are able to provide information to improve our reporting accuracy.
- Selection of suppliers who are working towards carbon reduction themselves.
- Use of overseas operatives where possible to reduce travel-related Scope 3 emissions.

Declaration and Sign Off

This Carbon Reduction Plan has been completed in accordance with PPN 006 and associated guidance and reporting standards for Carbon Reduction Plans.

Emissions have been reported and recorded in accordance with the published reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans and the GHG Reporting Protocol corporate standard¹ and uses the appropriate Government emission conversion factors for greenhouse gas company reporting².

Scope 1 and Scope 2 emissions have been reported in accordance with SECR requirements, and the required subset of Scope 3 emissions have been reported in accordance with the published reporting standard for Carbon Reduction Plans and the Corporate Value Chain (Scope 3) Standard³.
